### Methodology

The study was conducted for the <u>Annenberg Public Policy Center</u> of the University of Pennsylvania via web and telephone by SSRS, an independent research company. Interviews were conducted from **June 2 – June 22, 2021,** among a sample of **1,719** respondents in English (**1,686**) and Spanish (**33**). The web total respondents were **1,659** and there were **60** telephone respondents. Data were weighted to represent the target U.S. adult population. The margin of sampling error for total respondents is +/- **3.2** percentage points at the 95% confidence level. The design effect is **1.83**.
