1. The online survey will use the APPC Custom Logo. Study-specific revisions to the survey design will be made during the testing phase.
 - a. Font: GT America.
 - b. Respondents should be able to click anywhere within the radio buttons/check boxes or on the corresponding labels for those response options when selecting a response.
2. Each page of the online survey, including the [survey suspension page](#) (i.e. the page respondents see after they click the “Finish Later” navigation button), should contain the APPC custom logo, except for mobile devices.
